WRIT OF ELECTION

Ninety Sixth District – House of Representatives


WHEREAS, the Honorable Robin L. Webb, Representative from the Ninety Sixth Legislative District, having been duly elected Senator from the Eighteenth Senatorial District and administered the oath of office as required by Section 228 of the Kentucky Constitution; and

WHEREAS, by operation of Law, a vacancy now exists in the House of Representatives, Ninety Sixth Legislative District; and

WHEREAS, KRS 118.730 requires the Governor to issue a writ of election to fill a vacancy occurring in the House of Representatives when the General Assembly is not in session:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Steven L. Beshear, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, pursuant to the authority vested in me by KRS 118.730, do hereby issue a writ of election to fill the vacancy in the Ninety Sixth Legislative District, to be held on Tuesday, December 8, 2009, and hereby direct that this writ be forwarded to the Sheriffs of Carter and Lewis Counties as required by KRS 118.730 and 118.740.

The provisions of Executive Order 2009-1021 are hereby rescinded.
