


WHEREAS, the Honorable Dan Kelly resigned from the General Assembly, by letter dated October 26, 2009, and, as a result, a vacancy now exists in the Kentucky Senate, Fourteenth Senatorial District; and

WHEREAS, KRS 118.730 requires the Governor to issue a writ of election to fill a vacancy occurring in the Kentucky Senate when the General Assembly is not in session:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Steven L. Beshear, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, pursuant to the authority vested in me by KRS 118.730, do hereby issue a writ of election to fill the vacancy in the Fourteenth Senatorial District, to be held on Tuesday, December 8, 2009, and hereby direct that this writ be forwarded to the Sheriffs of Marion, Mercer, Nelson, Taylor and Washington Counties as required by KRS 118.730 and 118.740.

The provisions of Executive Order 2009-1022 are hereby rescinded.
